



ENGLISH FRIENDLY SIGNATURES

Classes for subjects classified as “English Friendly” are taught in Spanish. Therefore, student must have some prior knowledge of the Spanish language to be able to follow the lessons and explanations. In these subjects, students can access content in English.

They are intended for students who can understand classes in Spanish, but who do not feel confident enough to speak or take exams in Spanish and prefer to prepare the subject’s content using material in English.

What minimum content would these subjects classified as “English Friendly” provide?

1. Publish in UGRCat (<https://ugrcat.ugr.es/en/>) in English at least the “Theoretical and practical contents” section and the “evaluation” section of the teaching guide. The official Teaching Guide must be in Spanish.
2. Bibliography in English. The Teaching Guide will collect bibliographic material in English so that student can consult the content of the subject if the content of the subject allows it.
3. Slides (power point slides). The subject’s slides will upload to PRADO in two versions (English and Spanish). In class, the subject will be taught using the slides in Spanish version.
4. Practices/Exercises/Case studies. The practices, cases studies and/or exercises solved in classes and are the basis of content, will be offered in English and Spanish.
5. Exams and written tests (partial proof or class proof, ordinary, extraordinary, and special November exams). The exams or written tests developed throughout the semester will be offered in Spanish and English and the possibility of responding in English.
