





Adaptation Measures for University Teaching Return to In-Person Classes (April 2021)

Course 2020/2021

ADAPTATION OF UNIVERSITY TEACHING

The academic year 2020-2021 started in a hybrid way, with a **physical presence in the classroom of 50%** (approximately) of the enrolled students in each subject and group.

To that aim, the students enrolled in a group of a subject has been divided into two subgroups, depending on the letters by which their first surname begins:

- **Subgroup 1:** from A to L (both included)
- Subgroup 2: from M to Z (both included)

In addition, in order to organize **classroom attendance** for each of the subgroups, a **weekly rotation system** has been established among them, so that all students achieve a similar level of presence in the classroom throughout the semester.

Also, **cameras has been installed in the classrooms** to allow live transmission of the classes given at the classroom, **through videoconferencing**.

In this way, **face-to-face teaching is ensured** for all our student body, both for those who physically attend the classroom, and for the rest, who may be remotely present, following the class electronically.

The next table shows the **rotation shifts for the physical presence in the classroom**, of each of the subgroups into which each subject group is divided, for the last six weeks of the course:

Tutorials will be attended at the established timetable, by appointment. The aim is to ensure that they are carried out **electronically**. When conducted in person, the interpersonal distance of 1.5 meters must be respected and the use of a face mask will be mandatory. Only one teacher and one student can use the office.

HYGIENIC - SANITARY MEASURES

Main general measures of personal prevention against Covid-19:
 ☐ Mandatory use of a face mask without exhalation valve throughout the Faculty. ☐ Adequate hand hygiene using soap and water or hydroalcoholic gel. ☐ Interpersonal distance of at least 1.5 meters, whenever possible.
In the Classrooms:
 Classroom occupancy will not exceed 50% of its capacity, and in these cases people can be closer than 1.5 meters, always wearing a face mask. Signage of seats in the classroom: Seats with green dots → They allow an interpersonal separation of 1.5 meters.
These seats must be used first.
 Seats with orange dots → They allow the greatest interpersonal distance, without exceeding 50% of the capacity. They will only be used if there are no free seats with green dots.
 Unmarked seats → They cannot be used in any case.
☐ The student body will use the same seat as long as they remain in the classroom during the teaching day.
☐ Classrooms will be equipped with hydroalcoholic gel dispensers .
☐ Proper classroom ventilation .
Considerations when staying at the Faculty:
☐ Entry and exit circuits to the different buildings of the Faculty will be established to make people circulation easier, trying to avoid crowds.
☐ Circulation inside the Faculty will always be done next to the right wall , leaving the left side for the opposite direction of circulation.
☐ The formation of groups of people in corridors, common areas or passageways will be
avoided. These zones will be used exclusively for the movement of people.
☐ Elevators may only take one person at a time.
☐ Sharing pens, mobile phones, headphones and other utensils must be avoided .
☐ Water fountains will be shut down .
☐ The limited capacity of the different rooms of the Faculty must be respected : classrooms, study room, bathrooms, etc
