European Network of Business Schools Undergraduate Course of Study

The ENBS undergraduate course of study is an integrated programme leading to the award of the ENBS Undergraduate Certificate. To obtain the ENBS Undergraduate Certificate, students must be enrolled in a Bachelor Program at the home institution which comprises a minimum of 180 ECTS.



European Network of Business Schools Graduate Course of Study

The ENBS graduate course of study programme is an integrated programme leading to the award of ENBS Graduate Certificate. To obtain the ENBS Graduate Certificate, students must be enrolled in a Graduate Program at their home institution which comprises a minimum of 90 ECTS.
